



**PRESS STATEMENT**  
**On the outcome of the meeting of the**  
**Commission on Security Arrangements (COSA)**  
**Banda Aceh, 30<sup>th</sup> November 2005**

The Commission on Security Arrangements (COSA) today held its 21<sup>st</sup> meeting chaired by the Head of the Aceh Monitoring Mission Pieter Feith.

Delegations from Government of Indonesia and GAM attended. The delegation from the Government of Indonesia was headed by Gen. Bambang Darmono. The GAM delegation was Teungku Muhammad Usman Lampoh Awe, Teungku Zakaria Saman, Drs. Irwandi Yusuf, and Teungku Bakhtiar Abdullah.

The parties discussed the final phase of decommissioning. This will be discussed further at the next meeting.

The Government of Indonesia will relocate the remaining police for phase III on December 6<sup>th</sup>. The redeployment of non-organic troops and non-organic police during phase four will be discussed further at the next COSA meeting.

The parties will continue discussions regarding the registration of ex-GAM combatants.

The next meeting will take place Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2005 at 16.00.
